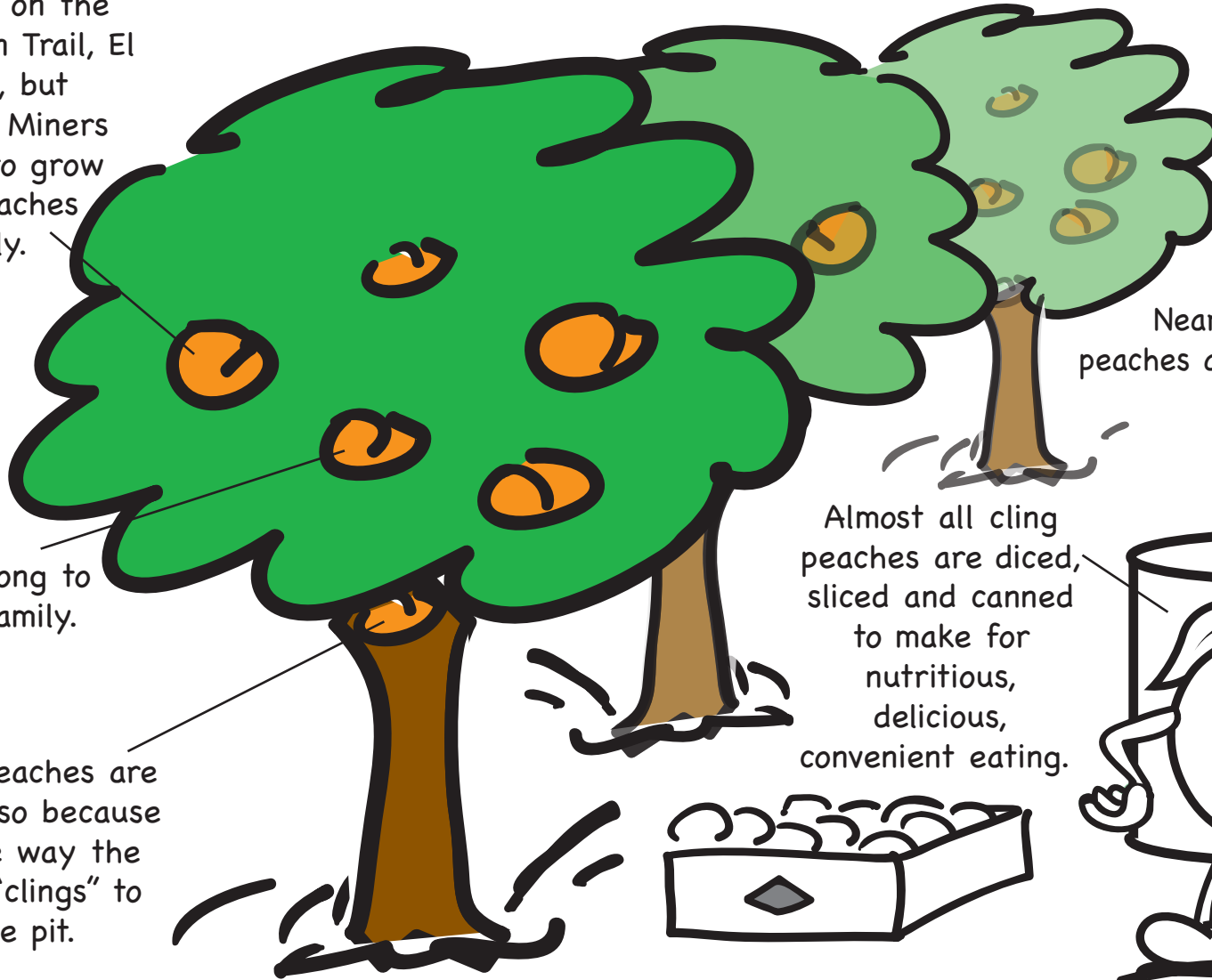


WHAT'S INSIDE A CALIFORNIA CLING PEACH ORCHARD
